Public Compliance Statement

Cuan Mhuire is committed to complying with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public and has formally discussed and adopted the Guidelines at a meeting of its Board.

- Cuan Mhuire confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising by a statement to that effect in its annual report.*

- Cuan Mhuire considers the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising when planning all fundraising activity.*
- Cuan Mhuire provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.*
- Cuan Mhuire has appointed a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising.*
- Cuan Mhuire ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.*
- Cuan Mhuire has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising.*
- Feedback is recorded for review by the CEO and the Board of Trustees.*
- Complaints and feedback are responded to promptly and appropriately.*
- Cuan Mhuire prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.*
- Cuan Mhuire ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and comply with data protection requirements.*
